The SmartXide² device significantly improves upon its predecessor by combining the DOT scanner and bi-polar radiofrequency (RF) for improved skin tightening and rejuvenation outcomes. Clinicians can use these two features separately or combine them for superior and longer lasting aesthetic results.

Featuring an intelligently integrated Plug and Play feature, the SmartXide² device also allows the clinician to simply add all scanning accessories as needed, thereby avoiding the necessity to recalibrate the laser for different indications before each treatment. This user-friendly function makes SmartXide² suitable for a variety of uses and indications. For example, the DOT/RF fractionated scanner provides photorejuvenation, the Hi-Scan surgical is useful in gynecology and ear, nose and throat (ENT) indications, as well as the V²LR scanning system for a unique, new application on the vaginal mucosa.

This novel device has proven efficacy in vulvo-vaginal laser reshaping (V²LR), a preventive treatment of vaginal atrophy caused mainly by menopause which can have a significant impact on patients. Equipped with its specially shaped DEKA-Pulse – exclusive to the SmartXide² system – SmartXide² has been shown to induce collagen stimulation of the vaginal mucosa for rejuvenation and tightening of the tissues.

Another feature of the SmartXide² is the Pulse Shape Design (PSD[®]) technology, allowing pulses to be delivered in any shape, specific to each individual treatment. The full spectrum of this innovative technology appears to be limitless as different pulse shapes can be applied for specific medical and aesthetic indications. With the advent of this technology, the range of super-pulses, ultra-pulses and hyper-pulses are now outdated, revealing a new frontier for CO₂ lasers.

"Using a specific pulse shape for the selected application not only helps achieve optimal results but also allows patients to have quicker outcomes with a decreased risk of adverse events postprocedure," advised professor Bonan.

An optional diode laser fiber can also be attached to the system, thus expanding the therapeutic spectrum of the device to include applications such as endosurgical and endovascular treatments. This versatility makes SmartXide² ideal for a complete therapeutic approach.
